



# EUROPEAN GUITAR FESTIVAL COLLABORATIVE

Dear competitor,

**The winner of this competition will be awarded the honour of becoming an EuroStrings Artist (ESA). ESAs will visit several EuroStrings festivals during a year.**

The EuroStrings (ES) project offers EuroStrings Artists a number of benefits which will lead to greater exposure for them as artists. These benefits will include activities such as performances, both solo and in ensemble, outreach work, masterclasses, lectures and entry into the ES Competition.

### **EuroStrings Artists activities:**

- 1) **Solo concerts** (min. 3 full or split concerts during the year)
- 2) **Master classes** given by world-known teachers & artists (min. 1 per festival)
- 3) **Master classes** given to younger guitarists (max. 2 per festival \*).
- 3) Playing in various **Chamber music** projects (min. 1 per festival)
- 4) **Outreach activities** (max. 2 per festival)
- 5) **Workshops & lectures** planned especially for EuroStrings Artists (min. 5 during the year)
- 6) **EuroStrings Guitar Competition** held in Petrer, Spain July 2020  
(Prizes: 8 000 € cash, concert Tour in Europe, USA and China)

### **Financial terms**

→ Travel expenses, accommodation and meals will be covered up to pre-agreed limits

→ 200 € scholarship from each festival

\* For more lessons at one festival there will be an additional fee agreed.

• If the winner has already been an EuroStrings Artist, or has won another EuroStrings competition during the same year or for some reason doesn't want receive this award, it will be handed to the next placed contestant of this competition.
